SUBJECT: Highly Qualified Teacher (HQT) Packets

Ohio will continue to require highly qualified teachers in core academic subjects in the 2017-2018 transition year as dictated by current state legislation, report card requirements and the state equity plan.

Since your "highly qualified" status is based on the actual courses you teach, this information has to be reported every school year. It does not matter if you completed this information last school year; it will need to be reported again per the Ohio Department of Education.

Included in this packet you will find a *Teacher HQT Status Sheet* for completion. Instructions for completing the form are also included. Please complete the form and return it to your principal or secretary <u>no later than</u> <u>December 8, 2017</u>. In instances where you meet the Highly Qualified Teacher's guidelines in more than one category, please use the lower number of the HQT status codes that is provided at the top right corner of your status sheet.

If you are not highly qualified, you will need to notify your principal.
